## City Winds Piano Trio

Crispian Fordham-Flute-has a BA (Mannes College of Music) and a Masters Degree (Mannes College of Music) in Music Performance on flute. He has studied with Keith Underwood (top instructor and lecturer across the world) and Nadine Asin (former piccolo & flute of the Metropolitan Opera). Mr. Fordham has performed with the Park Avenue Chamber Players , London Festival Players and many more. Mr. Fordham has performed many solo and chamber music performances in concert halls such as: Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, Steinway Hall and the United Nations. Also Crispian attended the Aspen Music Festival as a full Scholarship fellow. In 2001 Mr. Fordham won the award of excellence in Performance from the Mannes College of Music.

Meredyth Coleman-Oboe- has a BA (Univ. of Illinois Urbana-Champaign) and Masters Degree (Hartt School of Music) in Music Performance on oboe. She also has a Professional Studies Performance Diploma (Mannes College of Music) on English horn. Ms. Coleman teachers include Marion Arthur Kuszyk (Los Angeles Philharmonic) and Humbert Lucarelli (top recording artist) on oboe and Thomas Stacy (English hornist of the New York Philharmonic) on English horn. Ms. Coleman has performed with ensembles such as: the Emerson String Quartet, Bangor Symphony Orchestra, Illini Symphony Orchestra, Arcady Music Festival Orchestra and many more Symphonies throughout the country. Currently Ms. Coleman can be heard as the oboist on the television show *Lidia's Italy* on PBS. Meredyth has also won numerous awards including: Emerson String Quartet Top Prize and Best of Chamber Music Award from the Hartt School of Music.

Christopher J. Haberl – Piano – Chris Haberl has been musical director for various theaters in the metropolitan area and regionally. Chris was musical director, arranger and orchestrator for the opening of the new musical, *Lost and Found* in Sacramento, CA. Selected regional theatre: *Early One Morning* (Music by Ron Melrose), *Once Upon A Mattress*, *Into the Woods*, *Pirates of Penzance*. Chris' compositions include the musical score for *The Survivor*, and *Wait Until Dark*, straight plays which opened in New York in 2006 and 2007. While serving as an organist Chris has performed in churches across the East Coast and throughout Europe, with a performance at Galway Cathedral in Ireland. Chris' orchestral work includes guest appearances with St. Peter's Orchestra in New Jersey and Greenwich Village Orchestra. Performances with Andy Gale, Cindy Marchionda, Jennifer Naimo and Aretha Franklin.
